"I would like to have more options of cases with a subtle pattern on the outside"






Although the survey's respondants described their personal styles as "modern, colorful, eclectic, casual, timeless", 63% of them reported having a black case.



"You have to have it sealed up since airplane travel is super dry. Usually we recommend that if you're traveling overseas, to let it acclimate before you open it. Like on cold days we say to give it a few minutes to warm up, you don't want to shock it going from 20 degrees outside to room temperature around 68."

















A vertically standing case to be displayed in the home when not in use.

Integration of thermochromatic fabric to draw attention to temperature fluctuation in the case's surroundings.







Studying the thinnest and weakest points of the violin's body as well as the peak of the violin at the bridge.




Testing how different interior configurations affect the exterior form.





Integrating a system of variable straps into the form of the case.




Exploring the overlapping of the top and bottom shell for an airtight seal.

Elongating the side handle to match the grip with the center of gravity.














Testing the ergonomics of the case using weighted models.

CNCing both the interior and exterior shapes in EPS foam and using a foam coating on the exterior for durability.









Modeling the interior separately in it's intended materiality of cork and in the foam model in the context of the case as a whole.














The overall form of the case is recognizable by its sleek and sculptural peak.




The closure hardware on the case is a buckle used in more industrial settings on harnesses that can be found on roller coasters and airplanes. It has recently been translated into the context of fashion notably by the brand Alyx on a range of accessories. Its sculptural quality lends an expressiveness to an otherwise very functional detail of the case.



A strip of nylon attachment loops runs around the entire perimeter of the case allowing you to clip the straps on at any point to find the perfect fit.









Using the attachment loop system, the two main straps can be configured as a crossbody or a backpack depending on what you might be wearing.








The stabilizer strap can be used to create entirely new configurations.




The exterior lining of the case and the straps are nylon so they are easily customizable along with the exposed silicone gasket.





Nylon is a versatile material that comes in many forms. The exterior lining is a ripstop nylon used for the spinnaker sail on sailboats. In this form it's extremely durable and weatherproof. It is also much less susceptible to scratching than carbon fiber or aluminum cases that are made today.





As the violinist takes off their case, all of the necessary components they might need for playing including rosin, a mute and their chin rest are laid out around the instrument and easily accessible.








Cork is a natural insulator that can regulate temperature and humidity fluctuations which helps to preserve the violin especially during winter months and air travel. The cork can be dyed in vibrant colors during the molding process to further customize the interior of the case and match the foam suspension points that are necessary to absorb any shock around the body of the violin.











By collaboring with various brands, Apex can come out with limited edition versions of the case. Stone Island is known for their innovative material research, which aligns with Apex's goal of bending fashion and material technology.
